Smoke Alarms

- At least 1 smoke alarm on every floor
- We will change the battery as soon as the low battery alarm starts to beep
- We test each alarm every month
- We know batteries should be changed every 6 months
- We will never remove batteries to use in something else

Carbon Monoxide

- At least 1 carbon monoxide (CO) alarm on every floor
- We know that CO can kill us
- We know that CO is invisible and has no smell
- If the CO alarm goes off we know to get out and call the Fire Department

My Family's escape plan

- Touch doors to check for heat – if hot **DON'T OPEN**
- To avoid smoke, crawl low to the floor when escaping
- Agree on a **MEETING PLACE** after you have escaped
- We know that once we're out – **WE STAY OUT!**
- If trapped – go into a room, close the door, put a blanket at the Bottom of the door to stop smoke from coming in, open a Window and shout **HELP!!!**

When reporting a fire

- We know we must call from a neighbor's house
- We know the emergency phone number – 911
- We know that we must stay calm, speak slowly, and Give our address and if possible, the details of the fire

False alarms

- We know that false alarms are very dangerous.
- We know that false alarms waste time.
- We know that false alarms could cost lives.
